Other family members or friends are welcome to sign up too. Please look at the description of each volunteer position to see how old kids need to be to volunteer. IHN is the Interfaith Hospitality Network. We are a supporting congregation. Adath Israel is the hosting congregation and they open their space to homeless families in the community. These well vetted families arrive at Adath in time for dinner. After dinner the kids go to the game room for entertainment--project are usually provided,

Around nine pm the families each go to their assigned rooms to sleep. In the morning they are served breakfast and given food to pack for lunch. They take a bus and return to the IHN building. During the school year, kids go to school and the parents have job related training. They shower and take care of activities of daily living at the IHN building, but they sleep for one week at the host congregation. This is for family units which is unusual.
